

RATES

REUNION (August 19 - 21): \$150/person. Children under six, pay half; under two, no charge. Includes two nights lodging in camp cabins (with or without bath), meals Friday evening through Sunday lunch, limited activities, bedding, all functions. Upgraded accommodations (Gap, Ark, Cottages, Pooh, Infirmary) available at Family Camp rates listed below. Note that (depending on numbers) we may ask you to double up in a cabin.

FAMILY CAMP

(Ages 0 – 95, August 22 - 26)

Family Cabins, with baths, screened, bunk beds, \$120/day/person. Minimum two full paying guests, 4 nights.

Cabins without baths. Bunk beds, screened, central bathhouse. \$105/day/person. No minimum.

Gap. 3 rooms, 2 baths, on the edge of camp; ideal for large family. One queen, two twins, pullout couch in sitting room. \$130/day/person. Minimum 4 full paying guests, 4 nights.

Ark. Two small, separate, paneled bedrooms, duplex style, queen bed each side, with private baths, over the water, on the edge of camp; ideal for singles or couples. \$130/person/day, minimum 4 nights.

Nancy's Cottages (two). Our newest staff cabins, one room, queen bed, bath and kitchenette, porch with a view, private, perfect for a couple. \$140/person/day, minimum two full paying guests, 4 nights.

Pooh Corner. Renovated staff cabin at Green Cove, 4 bedrooms, 2 shared baths, paneled, shared kitchenette. \$120/person/day. EITHER: Minimum 6 full paying guests to reserve the whole building, OR: reserve individually and we may opt to put people in other rooms

Green Cove Infirmary. Two bedrooms, sleeping porch and kitchen, recently remodeled. \$120/person/day.

Included: Almost everything! Three full meals/day, all activities, most trips, airport pickup, sheets and blankets.

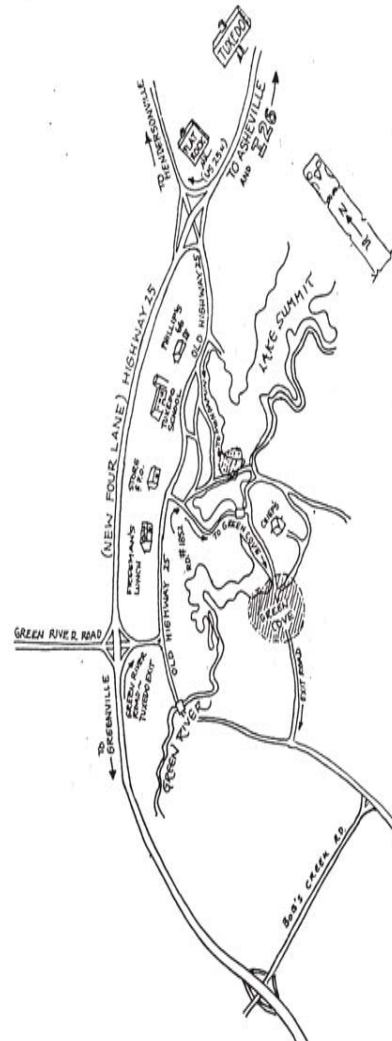

Minimum number of guests and nights listed may be waived if we have space at the last minute. Call!

Children age 6 and younger, under parental care, pay half. Children under 2, no charge.

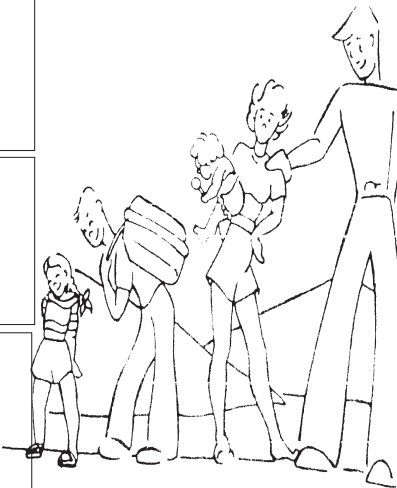

Reunion, August 19 – 21

The year 2011 marks Mondamin's 90th summer, and we plan to celebrate with a reunion! (See www.mondamin.com or www.greencove.com for details). The reunion will happen over the weekend of the 20th, and will roll right into Family Camp on Monday. The reunion will focus on renewing friendships, telling stories, campfires and square dances, and some limited activities. Family Camp will have more activities available (see below), including some climbing, biking and paddling outings. Staying for both is a great option. You won't need to move... there'll be some down time Sunday afternoon and evening, but programming for those staying will get underway Monday morning. *We will unabashedly use the reunion for fundraising for the Frank and Calla Bell Scholarship Fund (www.chiefandcalla.org).*

Family Camp, August 22 - 26

Family Camp, as noted above, is a chance to go back to camp again and resurrect those rusty skills... as adults, but with kids welcome too. We'll offer limited "day care" for age 2 and up while parents do activities.

Family Camp is a chance for adults and families to take a camp vacation. We program for a very active week! We take lots of trips to nearby rivers, rocks and wilderness areas. There's whitewater paddling for those who have the skills or can resurrect them from past years, or rafting for "river rats" not ready for a canoe or kayak. There's mountain biking at all skill levels, and hiking and rock climbing (including mostly day trips, but overnights too on demand). In camp, there are riding lessons and trail riding, sailing, tennis, swimming, and crafts. We'll teach you to paddle a canoe or a kayak, or let you experiment on your own. (You do have to be a good swimmer, about intermediate level, and you have to take a swim test). And though we love to do active, adventurous stuff, we can also arrange evenings at the movies, excursions to local places of interest, square dances, cook-outs, and other laid-back kinds of activities.

Cabins are... well, rustic. Screened, cots or bunks, right in camp and convenient to activities. Some have their own baths; some have central baths. Also available and not so rustic: the **Ark** (paneled room on the water, queen bed, ideal for a couple); the **Gap** (two bedroom, two bath apartment); **Nancy's Cottages** (our newest cabins, one-room, paneled with bath and kitchenette, queen bed, perfect for a couple); **Pooh Corner** (renovated staff cabin at Green Cove with 4 bedrooms and 2 baths); **Green Cove Infirmary** (2 bedrooms, 3 twin beds or one twin and one king, sleeping porch and kitchen). Pooh Corner, the Green Cove Infirmary and the cabins at Green Cove are about a mile from camp; you'll need to use your car to get back and forth. The dining room and most activities are at Mondamin.

All facilities are used at the user's risk, and camp reserves the right to determine readiness for any activity, such as whitewater canoeing. We'll ask you to sign a waiver regarding potential hazards associated with activities.

Singles and couples, with and without kids, camp alums or not, ages 0 – 95... welcome!

*If you're coming just for family camp (and not the reunion), then we'll ask you **not to come 'til lunch** (which is at 1:00) on Monday, to give us a chance to get your cabin ready after the reunion.*

For many years, we have had a 5 day August Camp running at the same time as Family Camp. For a number of reasons, we didn't like that arrangement, and have revamped the schedule for 2011: August Camp will become a full two week program for 7 - 12 year olds, and Family Camp will come afterwards. This year, the 90th Reunion will come in the middle of those two.
